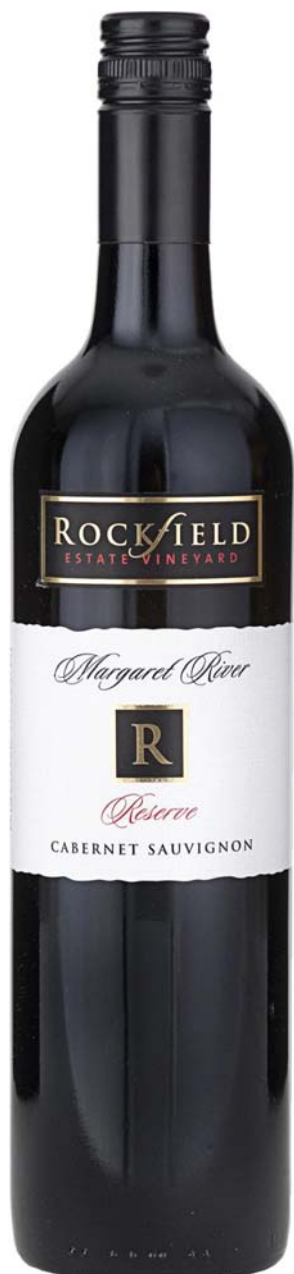

This wine is a single vineyard, terroir based expression of fruit typical of early Margaret River Cabernets. Extended barrel and bottle maturation has rewarded patience in this family reserve wine.
