VINTAGE/WINEMAKING NOTES

The Semillon fruit was picked in two parcels to ensure a balance of herbal and fruit characters, whilst the Sauvignon Blanc component was picked at an optimal ripeness to impart a combination of tropical and gooseberry flavours. Winemaking proceeded in two batches for each variety with partial barrel fermentation. Excellent varietal and regional Margaret River characters feature in this wine. The blend is 55% Semillon to 45% Sauvignon Blanc.

TASTING NOTES

This classic Margaret River style exhibits zesty lime, passionfruit, guava and nectarine, with vanilla and honeydew highlights through the palate.
