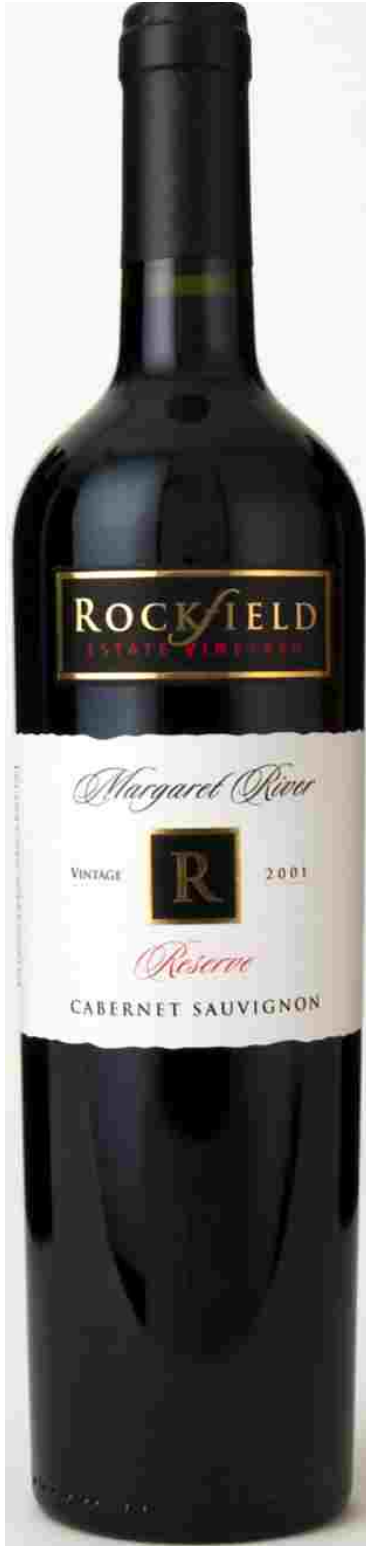




Margaret River Western Australia

Winemaking:

2001 was a great year for Margaret River Cabernet, and this wine is a single vineyard, terroir based expression of fruit typical of early Margaret River Cabernets. Concentration was obtained by selected hand tended fruit in combination with traditional wine making methods and new French Oak. Over 24 months of barrel maturation has rewarded patience in this family reserve wine.
