Winemaking:

Named after the district of Rosa Glen, the Rosa is based on lightly pressed Shiraz grapes that have been skilfully blended with select batches of other wines. It is a fresh rose-style wine and retains a small amount of residual sugar. Screw top closures were used to maximise vibrancy and freshness.

Tasting Note:

A refreshing rose-style wine displaying delightful strawberry, cherry, rose and violet aromas with further strawberry and Turkish delight on the palate.

Food: Rosa is ideal as an aperitif, and for summer picnics.
